Community Action Agencies are the federally designated anti-poverty network serving every community in New York State. Community Action Agencies provide direct services and support for education, employment and family support services to low income families. In addition to the direct services they provide, Community Action Agencies are leaders in promoting community economic development through community partnerships and inter-agency collaborations.

For more than 50 years, New York's Community Action Agencies have been a catalyst for change, testing new initiatives, developing innovative methods to eliminate the causes and effects of poverty and using results oriented measurement and reporting of outcomes.

The Community Action network of the Empire State, forms a statewide service delivery system that connects individuals and families to the services and resources they need to achieve economic security. Community Action Agencies achieve results that change lives and strengthen families.

Community Services Block Grant (CSBG)

CSBG is a federally, anti-poverty block grant which funds the operations of a state administered network of local agencies. In New York, the NYS Department of State administers the network. In 2017, NYS will receive approximately \$55,600,000 in CSBG funding.
